

## **PBF CONNECT GROUP STUDY GUIDE**

For the week of Mar 25-31

Romans 1:18-20: The Wrath of God Revealed

**Synopsis:** No human has an excuse before God since God has revealed himself to all people in creation. Man responds to that natural revelation by suppressing what he knows to be the truth. The result is the righteous wrath of God that is being revealed even now.

### **Into the Bible**

1. What is the wrath of God? What images does it bring to your mind?
2. What do we learn about God's character when we think about his wrath toward sin? How would it change our view of God if he didn't have wrath toward sin?
3. How is God's wrath "revealed" in Romans 1:18-32? Is there anything surprising to you about that?
4. What does it mean that men "suppress the truth in unrighteousness" (v. 18)? What truth are they suppressing?

5. What do you think can be known about God from creation?

6. What do you think it means that "they are without excuse"? Who is without excuse?

### **Application**

7. How might having a better understanding of the wrath of God impact your evangelism?
8. Does the statement, "Man's basic problem is not ignorance of the truth, but suppression of the truth" line up with your personal experience? Explain.
